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Thesis: God chooses many ways to communicate with us.

Objective: Youth to think about the ways God might be speaking to them.

Scripture: EACH SMALL GROUP TAKE SA DIFFERENT SCRIPTURE

1. Genesis 6:11-14 (God spoke directly to Noah)
2. Genesis 15:1-6 (God spoke to Abraham in a vision)
3. Judges 6:36-40 (...spoke to Gideon through dew on the grass)
4. Exodus 19:16-19 (...through lightning, thunder, trumpets, loud voice)
5. 1 Kings 19:11-13 (...through sheer silence)
